Dr Browne has provided assessment and intervention for inpatients and outpatients with psychological difficulties since qualification as a Clinical Psychologist in 2006.



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CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGIST IN NEUROPSYCHOLOGY In her neuropsychology positions at Addenbrooke's hospital, her outpatient diagnostic assessments have focused on differentiating between neurological and mental health presentations of psychological and cognitive symptoms. Inpatient services have focused on the assessment and treatment of the emotional, behavioural and cognitive sequalae of traumatic brain injury.

She held the position of Joint Head of the Neuropsychology Department at Addenbrooke's hospital between 2012 and 2020, when she grew a staff team from a compliment of two to twelve, led inpatient neuropsychology services for the Neuroscience division and the hospital more broadly, and developed policies and procedures for neuropsychological assessment and intervention within Addenbrooke's Major Trauma Centre since its advent in 2012.

Dr Browne continues to work for the Department as a Consultant and holds a lecturing position at the University of Cambridge.







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
