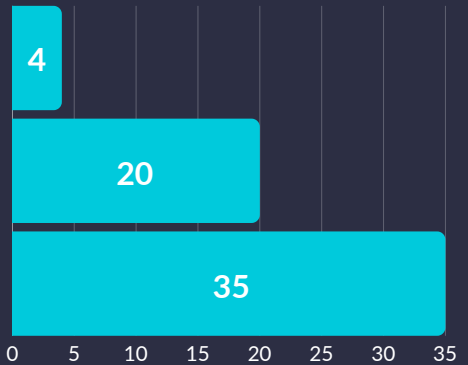

## CASES RELATING TO:

- **Personal injury:**
  - RTA
  - Slip/trip and falls
  - Accidents at work
  - Criminal matters
- **Clinical negligence:**
  - Misdiagnosis
  - Mistakes in treatment
  - Incorrect management of dental conditions
- **Implant Dentistry:**
  - Poor implant planning, placement or integration failure
  - Nerve damage or infection following implant surgery
  - Inadequate post-operative management
- **Orthodontics:**
  - Incorrect treatment planning or supervision
  - Root resorption, tooth mobility or poor occlusion outcomes
  - Retention or relapse issues due to inadequate retention planning
- **General Dentistry:**
  - Missed or delayed diagnosis of dental disease (caries, abscess, oral cancer)
  - Failure to diagnose or manage periodontal (gum) disease
  - Poor-quality fillings, crowns, bridges or veneers
  - Extraction errors (wrong tooth, nerve injury, sinus perforation)
  - Inadequate root canal (endodontic) treatment
  - Poor treatment planning or record keeping
  - Failure to obtain informed consent
  - Restorative dentistry and fillings
  - Problems with crowns, bridges and veneers
  - Complications with root canal treatments
  - Loss of teeth
- **Prosthodontics:**
  - Faulty dentures, bridges and crowns
  - Poor occlusal balance causing pain or temporomandibular joint (TMJ) dysfunction
