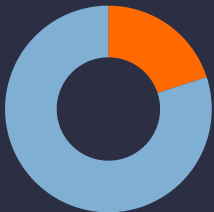
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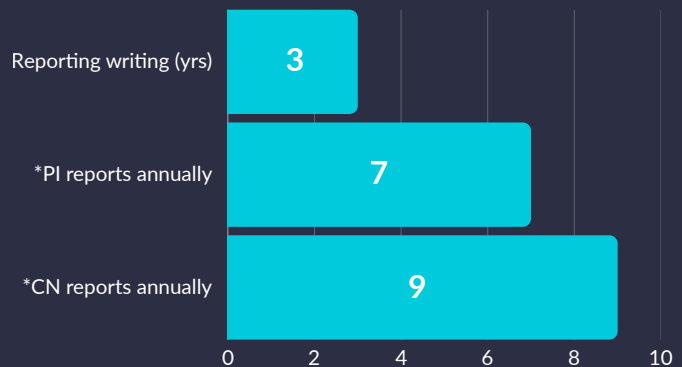

There he provided specialist assessments and interventions for individuals with complex learning disabilities. His leadership skills and clinical expertise saw him quickly promoted to Band 8a Acting Health Team Manager.
